FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Flowpoint showers will only work effectively on a PUMPED supply such as a Power Shower, or with a Combi or Condensing Boiler, or where a dedicated shower pump has been fitted to a Gravity fed shower system. They are not suitable for use on Electric Showers or Venturi Showers.

HH – Hand Held Models

Your *flowpoint* hand held shower, will screw directly into the existing conical fitting at the end of the shower hose by the ½" threaded pocket. Unscrew the existing shower. **Do not discard any rubber washer(s) that you may find inside the conical housing of the hose**.

'O' Ring (supplied)

It is better to fit the new shower head with your existing hose washers to check for leakage before fitting the 'O' ring supplied, if at all necessary.

NOTE – Conical hose ends vary in their threaded 'pocket' lengths. It is therefore not always possible or necessary to fit additional washers or the 'O' ring.

Unscrew the white protection cap at the end of the *flowpoint* shower handle. Fit and screw up the hose to the handle.

The shower is ready for use.

<u>IF</u> there is leakage between the handle and the hose you can fit the 'O' ring onto the handle end thread of the shower and re-fit the hose again tightening to the 'O' ring. Do not over tighten. If you still experience leakage, you can purchase from any DIY store, 'PTFE Thread Tape ' which is used to wrap around pipe threads to prevent leaks and is a standard plumbing accessory.
